Chris handed out a list of thoughts she'd had about what could be discussed. She mentioned that there were a lot of things that we can do without knowing the date of our show and T-shirt list included her "brain dump" of items as a start.

Chris said that a date for our show is a moving target since clubs are moving their dates around all the time, and it won't be until we have the go-ahead from AKC that we can actually choose a date, (figuring out what buildings are available at the fairgrounds) and publicize it to make sure no one else is planning for that date. But in the meantime, many other things can be already planned.

### Goal

The group discussed what was important to us as a club in putting on a show and everyone agreed that the exhibitors should be a priority. Our goal should be to make exhibitors want to come to our show. Potential numbers of entries was discussed with a consensus being around 1000-1100 entries. It will probably be larger our first year.

### Ideas to Attract Exhibitors

These are ideas thrown out by the members, not a list of what is planned. Our budget will control what we can and cannot do.

- Good judges not the overused ones, and not Canadians
  - Group consensus was that we use a committee to hire judges rather than having the Show Chair do it. They would start with recommendations by the members and then give the members a proposed slate before hiring.
- Have a theme
  - Hawaiian
  - Cops & Robbers
  - Pirates
- Provide donuts in the morning
- Pizza party
- Help with daily unloading, reloading
- Offer rosettes as many as we can, especially not flat ribbons for NOHS groups
- Clothes for juniors Sandy said Laura Reeves is interested in working with us on that
- Specialties we want to encourage specialty clubs to go in with us. We could use a
  Friday afternoon setup day for specialties so we may not have to pay as much for the
  fairgrounds buildings. Offer rebates to clubs having specialties.
- NOHS offer both days (will exhibitors stay around for Sunday groups?)
- Offer other groups
  - Best BBE
  - Champion BBE

- Foreign-bred sweepstakes
- o 4-6 Puppy
- o Others?
- Dock Diving
- FAST CAT
- Decided not to include agility at this time
- AKC Scent Work

#### Costs

Since we don't have a large treasury and offering some of these things costs money, what can we do to help raise more funds?

- Corporate donors get local business to fund, then have banners on the rings
  - Get more than one corporate sponsor
- Work with local business and Visitors Bureau use stats from AKC website for how much shows contribute to the local economy. Use them to help with hotels, donors
- Raffle
- Charge for reserved grooming
- Get lots of vendors
  - Recruit from local shows, but also non-dog vendors maybe some from Saturday Market?
  - Charge usually around \$50-100/day?
- The group felt we should <u>not</u> charge for spectators (at least to start with)
- Get sponsors for group awards

### Hotels

- Need to find hotel for judges
  - Near where airport shuttles drop off
  - HUT \$54 round trip (every 2 hrs)
  - Oregon Shuttle \$47 RT (every hour)
- Need to find hotels that take dogs for exhibitors

# Parking

- Need to hire someone to do parking
- Karen Stenlund NW Dog Show Parking is best bet for RV parking
- Fairgrounds does their own day parking

## Superintendent

The group discussed the 3 main superintendents in this area, Onofrio, BaRay, and MB-F. It was the consensus of the group that while price is important, the quality of their work was also important. The group decided that we should ask BaRay and Onofrio for bids.
